



Associate Director of Partnerships and STEAM

Student Leadership Network (SL Network) supports three life-changing programs that empower students to break the cycle of poverty through education: The Young Women's Leadership Schools (TYWLS), a high-performing network of all-girls public secondary schools, Young Women's Leadership Network (YWLN), a group of National Affiliate schools modeled after TYWLS, and CollegeBound Initiative (CBI), a school-based college access program for young women and men. The Associate Director of Partnerships and STEAM (ADPS) will be responsible for setting the vision and strategy for all Leadership, STEM, and Arts partnerships as well as all STEAM initiatives at our five TYWLS schools. The person in this position will work to solidify our national STEAM model for our Affiliates. S/he is responsible for all programs, events related to STEAM, including summer programs and theatre arts. The AD of Partnerships and STEAM reports to the Managing Director of TYWLS and will leverage the support of five TYWLS STEAM liaisons and a college or graduate school intern to execute the school based partnerships STEAM vision and plan.

Primary Roles and Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Develop and Direct the implementation of the STEAM strategy in accordance with the Strategic Plan
- Oversee all TYWLS partnerships in leadership, STEM and the arts and manage all STEAM events, programs and special opportunities including all arts and theatre opportunities
- Work in collaboration with the Senior Manager of Health and Wellness to implement related partnerships
- Collaborate with YWLN team and leverage partnership resources to develop relevant resources or Professional Development for STEAM focused affiliate or other national work
- Determine, along with MD TYWLS, which partnerships have the biggest impact and scale vs. those that are ineffective or need revision
- Oversee the FY21 Partnership and STEAM budgets and plan for the FY20 budgets
- Synthesize, analyze, and define key performance metrics across each program partner to measure the efficacy and impact of our student programs ("e.g. student surveys and/or quantified leadership and STEAM experiences")
- Prepare summaries, presentations, and/or other materials that summarize findings for internal and external audiences
- Work closely with the Development team on funding opportunities for Girls in STEAM/STEAM summer programming
- Work with TYWLS school administration and teachers to off load leadership programs previously run by our team
- Develop and manage a team of STEAM Liaisons and a TYWLS intern

- A demonstrated passion for expanding educational opportunities for students from low-income communities and belief in SL Network's mission
- Extensive leadership experience in school based partnerships and programs
- Deep knowledge of best practices in STEAM initiatives, partnerships, and pedagogy, girls' education experience preferred
- Bachelor's degree from an accredited 4-year college or university, master's degree preferred



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- A strong history of working successfully with partner schools, NYC DOE school experience preferred
- Non-profit managerial experience
- Superlative planning, organizational, and writing skills
- Ability to effectively collaborate across teams and communicate with diverse stakeholders
- Teamwork, collegiality, and a joyful approach to the work is required.
