Before You Begin...

What is a brag sheet?


A brag sheet is very similar to a student resume – it highlights your accomplishments, experiences, leadership skills, and employment throughout your high school career. Essentially, it's a quick reference guide with all of the details and achievements that can be used as a tool for a recommender who is starting the writing process for your letter of recommendation. You can fill out the template included in the following pages and provide that to your recommenders.



Tips for Completing A Brag Sheet

- Think about which teachers know you the best. Who can speak to your interests and abilities?
- Spell out the name(s) of any received Award(s)/Honors and/or participating clubs instead of using acronyms.
- Provide details of achievements and quantify when possible. For example:
 - **DON'T WRITE**- "'Cal Prep High School Leadership Award' for being a leader in my high school."
 - **DO WRITE**- "'Cal Prep High School Leadership Award' for assisting teachers at my school with coordinating, planning, and implementing 3 events for 80 students, serving as a mentor to 11th-grade students, and fundraising \$1000 for a college visit. This award is only given to 3 students in my school."
- Include any responsibilities, achievements, or activities outside of school (i.e. at home/in your family, in your community, etc.).


